

Activity 1: Quick audit questions

Purpose

To raise awareness about SRE in the school and initiate further parental involvement.

Outcomes

By carrying out this survey:

- parents and schools will have entered into a basic dialogue about SRE
- the school will have benchmark data about parents' awareness and involvement.

Notes to facilitator

These questions could be communicated through a virtual learning environment (VLE), text message, website survey tool or on paper. The advantage of using an electronic tool such as a web-based survey is that the responses can be counted automatically. Explain to parents why you want their views and what you intend to do with them. Keep a record of how many parents respond and their answers.

The questions

- Did you know there is a school policy on sex and relationships education (SRE)?
